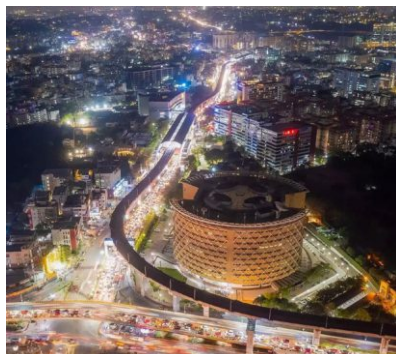
The Pearl City, Hyderabad
